

Bali classic - The island of the gods **(09 days / 08 nights)**

Discover the classic Bali

From beautiful mountains to miles of coastlines to volcanic hillsides to black sandy beaches, Bali is known as the Island of the Gods. Between the Java and Lombok island, Bali boasts a rich and diverse culture that's unique. The Balinese architecture is combined with the island housing thousands of Hindu temples in every nook and cranny. The predominantly Hindu culture makes the difference in the Muslim dominated country of Indonesia.

- **Visit to monkey forest, traditional market, museum, and palace in Ubud**
- **Visit to Tegalalang area and short walking through the rice field**
- **Visit to : the Fruits and Vegetables market in Candi Kuning Village and Ulun Danu Temple in Bedugul, on the way to Lovina.**
- **Dolphin watching in Lovina**
- **Visit to Beji temple, Kintamani village with spectacular views of mountain Batur and the lake Batur, Kehen temple near Bangli, and the bat cave on the way to Candidasa**
- **Visit to Besakih temple, Tenganan village and the Bali old Court Justice**

ITINERARY:

DAY 01: SOUTH BALI – UBUD

Upon arrival at the airport, our guide will welcome you with a flower garland then transfer you to an artisan village of Ubud for accommodation. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 02: UBUD (B)

After breakfast at hotel. Morning visit to Monkey forest, traditional market, Museum and the Palace of Ubud. Then forward to Tegalalang area to see and short walking through the rice field. Back to hotel for overnight.

DAY 03: UBUD - LOVINA (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Leave Ubud and travel further north into the mountain to the village of Bedugul. Pass through quiet villages far from the normal tourist route while traversing rice terraced valleys. On the way visit the flower and spice market at Candi kuning and Ulun Danu temple at Bratan Lake. Time for a stop to Gitgit waterfalls before travelling on to the northern beach town of Lovina. Arriving in the late afternoon, Overnight at hotel in Lovina.

DAY 04: LOVINA – CANDIDASA (B)

Early this morning before breakfast, there is time for a boat trip to see dolphins playing off the after a swim shower and breakfast. Visit Banjar hot-springs before leave Lovina to the Eastern part of Bali, Candidasa. Taking a coastal road leads Candidasa. Enroute stop at Beji temple, built out of red brick and completely covered in carvings. The Subak or rice irrigation society temple dates back to the 15th century. It is probably the most baroque looking temple on the island. Enroute we will stop at Kintamani where you can see the smoking Mt Batur with its Lake Batur. On the way to Candidasa visit the famous Kehen temple near Bangli, then Goa Lawah (bat cave). In the afternoon arrive candidasa direct to hotel for overnight.

DAY 05: CANDI DASA (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Start the tour via country side road of Babandem known with its rice terrace. Enroute you take a short walk at local tropical plantations and rice terraces. We continue the trip to the Besakih, its called as the mother temple of Bali, located in the slope of Mt Agung. In the afternoon, take a different route return to Candidasa, with a visit Old court of Justice and then to the very traditional village of Tenganan, known with its unique culture and double ikat weaving. Return to hotel for overnight.

DAY 06: CANDIDASA – NUSA DUA (B)

Breakfast at hotel. At the mid day transfer to the South of Bali.

DAY 07-08: NUSA DUA FREE PROGRAM (B)

Today you will have a free program. You are free to spend your time whether to relaxing yourself at the hotel or explore the city by yourself. There is so many interesting place to visit while you are in Bali, ask our experienced representatives to give you recommendation or advice. Our representatives will gladly assist you with all their knowledge to make your trip perfect.

DAY 09: NUSA DUA – DENPASAR (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Free until time for transfer to airport for your onward flight to the next destination.
